These days there are fewer of us and we are sometimes away for a variety of reasons, so we encourage you to ask for the Sacrament of the Sick in good time, before being admitted to hospital or when you or your relatives are seriously ill, so that we can arrange a time to visit and offer this sacrament of healing, encouragement and consolation. If you or relatives are admitted to hospital, please ask the nursing staff to contact the Catholic Chaplaincy team and request a visit. Especially we ask you, whether at home or in hospital, not to wait until your loved one is so close to death that they cannot appreciate the grace they are receiving. People sometimes worry that their loved one will be frightened by this rite but our experience is that the sacrament provides a help and support in times of illness and especially for those approaching death.
